The Second Semester of the school year has started!! For students in all grades 9-12, we cannot stress enough the importance for making sure you are taking full advantage of your regular class time, Raider Block/Flex time, and afterschool time, to complete the curricular work in each of your classes, therefore meeting the standards necessary to become fully educated in that subject and achieve credit and success. An important reminder about credits needed to achieve the next level in grade status:

****You need 6 credits to move on to Gr. 10** **You need 12 credits to move on to Gr. 11 ****You need 18 credits to move on to Gr. 12**

If you have any questions or concerns, please talk with your teachers and email your school counselor.

Coming next month – March 23rd – all members of the junior class statewide will be taking the Ct. School Day SATs. The SAT for the School Day will be digital and will require you to bring your laptops to school fully charged. In the coming weeks we will be setting up a pre-administration and practice session to get you prepared and ready to take the exam.

To assist with preparation for this exam and future SATs- students should be able to review their PSAT scores found on their College Board Accounts as well as practice math and reading skills. Please encourage your student to go onto their College Board accounts to review their PSATs and work on math and evidence-based reading and writing questions!

Now that First Semester has ended and grades have closed, the school counseling department will send mid-year grades to those colleges to which students have applied.

If you have schools that you are still going to apply to, you need to make sure that your school counselor is aware of what you have submitted so that transcripts and official documents can be sent to the college/university.

**Word of Caution: For those that have been accepted and knowing that the first semester has ended, this is not the time to let "senioritis" sneak in! Colleges and Universities do ask for final grades and there are times when a post-secondary institution will reverse an acceptance decision due to lack of academic effort in the second semester.
